

Meeting Minutes - Salmon Creek Fly Fishers  
May 27, 2021

Jay Woodbury Called the meeting to order at 6pm

There was no guest speaker this month

John Farley reported about the Coldwater trip and the Deschutes trip

- The Coldwater trip had about 14 participants and was very successful. The weather was cold but everyone caught fish and had a great time
- The Deschutes trip had about 6 people. The weather was warm/hot and breezy. The salmon flies were just starting to show and the fish were not quite keying in on them. Evening caddis and mayflies worked best.

There is a sign up for the Goose lake outing which has been rescheduled for June 5th. The road from Carson is still impassable due to snow and the lake has yet to receive its first planting. Usually WDFW stocks 10-15000 fish around this time and it is best to go after the lake receives its first plant. Therefore, the trip may be rescheduled again pending stocking and road status. Bob Williams will be the fishmaster for this trip. Please contact Bob if you have any questions.

Swift Reservoir opens Saturday. There is a pop up outing of about 5 members who are planning to go.

There has been concern that weekday outings limit some members from attending.
